The Community Benefit Committee of Grande Ronde Hospital is seeking applications from not-for-profit organizations for community grant funding in accordance with the Committee's Mission:

COMMUNITY BENEFIT COMMITTEE MISSION

The Community Benefit Committee, in support of Grande Ronde Hospital's Mission and Vision, strives through collaborative efforts with other not-for-profit, community focused organizations, to identify and support the priority needs of Union County, with an emphasis on the underserved.

The Committee has limited grant funds available for distribution for Fiscal Year 2011, beginning May 1, 2010. Our funding priorities are based upon an independent community-wide needs assessment conducted for the Community Benefit Committee:

TOP THREE FUNDING PRIORITIES FOR FY2011

1. Combating drug use in Union County
2. Meeting the basic needs of our community (i.e., food, shelter)
3. Providing wellness/preventative care

In addition to meeting the criteria of the funding priorities, the following information must be included with your application in order for your request to be considered:

1. Budget
2. Supporting Data: Including quantitative data to support proven practice or outcomes, letters of recommendation, and/or letters to support the need for funding.
3. Copy of Tax Exempt Determination Letter
4. Project Summary: Once project/activity is complete, you will be expected to submit a summary report/evaluation of the project/activity to the Community Benefit Committee.

Applicants MUST have a current 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, tax-exempt status under IRS Code Section 170, or be a governmental agency/department or public educational institution to be eligible for funding consideration.

ONLY completed applications will be considered.

Completed applications MUST be received by 5 PM, June 30, 2010.
